The project, "Listen up! Have You Heard Any Good Books Lately?" is a reading project that will provide fluency, vocabulary and comprehension support for targeted at-risk readers and provide comprehension growth for at-level/above readers. Students will use play-away recorded books to listen to text aloud while following along with the book.

2. What is the **GOAL** of your project. What **OBJECTIVES** will you use to meet this goal?

The goal of the project is to give comprehension and fluency support to struggling students while developing target students' vocabulary.

Objectives:

- Increase students' reading fluency by providing play-away technology of recorded text.
- Increase students' comprehension by providing support of the text by listening to the recorded texts.
- Increase students' vocabulary through the use of play-away technology.
- Increase students' independent reading levels by having them listen to books at higher reading levels

3. What student **ACADEMIC NEED** or **PROBLEM** does this project address? How did you identify the need the project will address, and why is this project unique? Why do you consider this project to be an innovative solution to this need?

Students at our school are categorically lower in reading than math on standardized tests such as the Leap and iLeap. We have identified reading fluency and comprehension as target areas to increase student achievement. The School Improvement Plan (SIP) has identified goals to increase student achievement in ELA (English Language Arts) in grades three, fourth and fifth. Desired outcomes are to improve vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension in ELA. Specific target students will be identified as the African American Subgroup and the Students with Disabilities Subgroup as they performed below and drastically below the white subgroup respectively. Targeting this subgroup is important because the district went into school improvement over the African American Subgroup. In 2012-2013, we increased in accuracy on A.R. quizzes since we have been offering play-aways for library check-out. Our 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders averages on A.R. quizzes went up from 84.2% in 2011-2012 to 87.2% in 2012-2013. The average book level that students are testing on has also increased by a reading level of 1.2 due to the implementation of play-away/books at higher reading levels. Our school was also a Top Gains' School in 2011-2012. We showed an annual growth of 2.7 in 2011-2012. We would like to continue on this upward trend by adding more play-aways to our library's collection & give students more opportunities

to use them. All students below level and above level will have access to this technology working alongside to eliminate discrimination by ability.

This project is unique because it incorporates technology into the English Language Arts curriculum. Using play-aways is unique because students are attracted to devices such as MP3 players and play-aways resemble these devices. All levels of achievement can improve their listening capability which in turn will allow students to build their comprehension level which will in turn allow for better comprehension when teachers are giving instructions and instructional learning.

At-risk students identified as Tier 2 and Tier 3 in Response to Intervention (RTI) as well as students identified as strategic and intensive in DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) assessments will be chosen as the target group along with the two subgroups mentioned earlier to increase fluency and comprehension. Also, students that are on-grade level and above-grade level will have access to play-aways. These students will serve two purposes: first to increase comprehension and support for above level text to enrich their vocabulary, secondly to level the playing field for struggling students and those on and above level.

When both groups are using the play-aways to strengthen their reading practice, the lower level readers will not be discriminated as needing the extra assistance and support the play-aways provide. The at-risk students will feel comfortable using the play-aways because their above level peers are using them. The play-aways increase fluency because students hear fluent readers reading and are able to read with them following along with the novel. Also, the play-aways have an option for struggling readers to slow down the narration so they are able to follow along at their own pace. This option individualizes instruction and differentiates for their personal needs. Students can hear how good readers pause and read phrases together. Listening to good readers increases struggling readers' ability to read naturally.

We need to provide technology support for our struggling readers. We have novels in our library but need to provide play-aways to support the text as struggling readers need the assistance to build fluency while improving listening comprehension. Giving this support allows student to use working memory to process the text and comprehend rather than using working memory to sound out words and understand how vocabulary interacts with the rest of the text.

5. What are the plans/possibilities for **CONTINUATION** of this project beyond the grant completion? How will this project influence your classroom instruction and your school? If it is to continue after grant expiration, how will it be funded, if applicable? **CAN** and **HOW** can this project be completed by other schools?

Since the play-away devices are reusable, many students will be able to check out the devices along with the novel, listen and read along, and return to the library. The recorded novels on the play-aways also have Accelerated Reader quizzes, so parents, students, and teachers will be able to monitor the student's reading practice. The only funding that will take place will be to replace batteries as needed. The library enhancement fund will provide funding for batteries and replacement novels.

Students in grades 3-5, 190 students will incorporate play-aways into their reading practice. The targeted at-risk group will have first priority but above level students will be using the play-aways alongside struggling students to ensure that students are not discriminated against.

Mid-summer 2013: Order play-aways & books

Late Summer 2013: Target groups identified which consist of African-American students, students with disabilities, & struggling readers in RTI Tiers 2 and 3.

Late August 2013: Librarian introduces how to use play-aways to students in grades 3, 4, and 5.

Marking Periods 2013-2014: End of 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> 9-week periods: Students will conduct a classroom presentation of their play-away & book. Teachers will also monitor & assess students reading throughout the 9-week periods.

Summer 2014: Targeted Subgroups will be evaluated to see if progress was made using standardized data.

8. Would implementation of this program still be possible with partial funding? **Please explain.**

Yes, implementation of this program is possible with partial funding but on a smaller scale. With full funding, we will be able to target a larger amount of students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> which will show more of an increase. With partial funding, fewer play-aways, books, & earbuds will be ordered.

All students will be assessed on their progress as well as the African American Subgroup, and Students with Disabilities Subgroup using the *LEAP* and *ILEAP* standardized tests in the ELA portion of the test. All students will be tested using summative assessments after each unit using *EDUSOFT* and *Assess to Know* to assess each child's reading comprehension. Students will be assessed on fluency during Winter and Spring Benchmark using DIBELS. Teachers will monitor students' comprehension using Accelerated Reader Diagnostic report that will tell how students scored on their comprehension quiz. Teachers can monitor students average percent correct score to ensure students are making gains. Teachers will use these reports as a formative assessment, making decisions for each individual child based on the performance using the play-aways.
